Foundation Center Report on Giving Estimates and Outlook

The first of the series, the just-released 2010 edition of *Foundation Growth and Giving Estimates: Current Outlook*, reports a record decrease of 8.4 percent in foundation giving in 2009. To put this into context, during previous economic downturns in 1983, 2002, and 2003, foundation giving declined by less than 1 percent. The report projects that 2011 will be flat but that the success of the rebound that began late last year will influence whether there is actually a slight increase or decrease in the outlook.
